Martina Vandenberg, Human Rights Attorney in Washington, D.C. will highlight her work in seeking “Justice for Victims of Trafficking.”

A Gilroy High School graduate (1986), Ms. Vandenberg continued her studies in International Relations at Pomona College at Claremont and attended Oxford (St. Antony’s College) on Rhodes and Truman Scholarships. Her Law degree is from Columbia University in New York.

Ms. Vandenberg spent three years in Russia working in the Women’s Movement setting up Rape Crisis Hot Lines. She did research in Kosovo, working for Human Rights Watch, where she succeeded in gaining indictments for “Rape as a War Crime” following the conflict.
